

The Wonewoc-Center School District has an opening for a night custodian. Some weekend hours may be required on occasion. This position will begin on June 1, 2026, and is a 12-month position. There will be opportunities to work as a substitute custodian before start date.

Certification: Must hold a valid Wisconsin Driver's License.

Duties/Qualifications:

- Experience working in the school setting or custodial field is desired but not a must.
- First Aid, CPR and defibrillator training desired. Training will be provided to a successful candidate.
- Ability to communicate and maintain good working relations with all District employees.
- Contribute to a positive school culture and climate.
- Communicate effectively with supervisor/administration.
- Initiative and ability to work independently and stay on task; sound judgment and decision-making capabilities are essential.
- Performs minor repair and maintenance as authorized by Maintenance Director.
- Janitorial experience and custodial cleaning techniques is preferred, but not required
- Ability to understand written and verbal communications
- Ability to walk/stand for extended periods of time
- Ability to lift and/or move 50 lbs.
- Expectation of ethical conduct and confidentiality in all aspects of the work environment
- Performs other duties as assigned.

This position will be responsible for duties maintaining the building. In addition to regular building maintenance and cleaning functions, this position will work with the Maintenance Director performing routine maintenance repairs, snow/ice removal, and other functions as assigned. Evening activities will be part of the job duties.

Pay rate for this position will depend on experience.
